Ash Wednesday begins the season of Lent. This year it falls on February 14th. That's right, in 2024 Ash Wednesday and Valentine's Day occur on the same day, for the first time in several years. On Ash Wednesday, Christians face the fact that as human beings, we will die by having ashes placed on our forehead. We also remember that because of Jesus' death and resurrection, death is not a permanent condition for us.

The season of Lent ends during Holy Week, when we remember the arrest, trial, crucifixion, burial and resurrection of Jesus and all that it means for us. Jesus' passion and resurrection may be seen as God's valentine to us, not just on one day but all our lives and beyond, a lasting assurance that God in Christ's unfailing love for us stops at nothing to be with us and to save us.

On Wednesday evenings during Lent this year we will gather each week at Borgund, Minnesota Valley, or Zion. We will share fellowship, a light meal, and worship together. The dates and locations for successive Lenten Wednesdays can be found in the Lenten schedule in this newsletter.

This year the theme of our Lenten Wednesday worship series is Near the Cross and Tomb of Jesus. We will consider the experience of a number of people in the Gospels who were with or interacted with Jesus in some way during his trial, crucifixion, burial or resurrection, and what their stories might tell us about Jesus. Please join us Wednesday evenings this Lent to experience God's love and grace.

Come; let us gather for worship and fellowship. All are welcome. Please invite a friend or neighbor!

December Treasurer's Notes

- Attached is the latest 2023 Expenditures & 2024 Budget Proposal. These are final totals for 2023.
 Thank you for all your help in making this process successful!
- All end of year financial donations have been made. Zion had tremendous support from the congregation in the Mission Fund. In 2023, \$6,930.00 was given with \$1,100 going to local organizations & \$5,830 to the SW MN Synod Mission Support.
- Two Zion College Freshmen received \$250 scholarships from the scholarship CD. After subtracting the \$500, the CD was renewed.
- The Tri-Parish financial split/obligations were reviewed by the church treasurers. It was agreed
 the Tri-Parish agreement stated the first 30% should be divided equally with the remaining 70%
 divided 50-30-20%. March through December were recalculated and MN Valley and Borgund will
 be paying soon to clear 2023 expenses.

Questions about splitting the parsonage expenses have come up through this review. Mainly to not include parsonage utility expenses in the Tri-Parish Expenses. One item of note is that the Madison parsonage has been rented out to one of their parishioners.

Here is the note from Brian and Tamie:

"We would like to suggest one additional change. We also believe we should make corrections to the expenses for the church parsonages. Article VI of the agreement says that each congregation retains ownership of its church property and its parsonage property, and is responsible for associated physical upkeep. Article VIII a says "Each congregation will be responsible for their own financial obligations, including their property, debt, and other staff not included in the Tri-Church ministry." The intent was that Borgund/MNV continue to split all expenses related to the parsonage in Madison and that Zion pay for all expenses related to the parsonage in Appleton. We have not calculated the impact that this will have on the total amount due but either way, suggest that we correct it at the same time. Do you agree with this approach?"

When parsonage utilities were brought up by the treasurers previously, I mentioned it with a few council members. Those Zion's council members seemed to be in agreement that we are responsible for our own parsonages as far as physical upkeep is concerned, but felt the utilities should be a shared expense. Whether it is the pastor or intern in either of our parsonages, that is their home office. In their ministry they are always on call and many times work at home.

Please discuss the matter with a recommendation. It will be discussed at the next Executive Board meeting.

 Ted Albers has also agreed to review the church's finances. At six-month intervals, both Ted and Andrew Schmidt will review the accounting. Afterwards it will be kept in the church for anyone else wishing to review. January through June 2023 have been reviewed by both with no issues found. July through December will be reviewed soon.




